


### A Computer Filing System


- Drives Usually the physical Hard drive
- Folders containers to put your files or other folders
- Files the documents, pictures, music, spreadsheets etc
- Mobile phone uses the same principle with folders and files
  - Eg phone/DCIM/Camera/ will contain your photos
  - phone/pictures/screenshots/ contains screenshots

## Windows filing system





### Avoid nesting too much – becomes hard to find things






Journaling – helps record useful info about the folder's content.






# To create a quite notes journal I use file explorer.



Computer/phone pictures contain additional information. (Meta data)






# Photo viewers apps use Indexes and Tags to give different album views.



There is no need to sort photos into subjects as they can be tagged to access them. A single photo may appear in more than one album without being copied.
