


Setting Shortcuts

Making things easier

Text input options

- Keyboard with/without auto correct.
- Swype/Swiftkey very fast
- **Text SIZE**
- Look under Settings (enter text in search bar)

Screen gestures are phone specific

- Screenshot
- Commonly power+volume buttons
- Honor – knuckle tap, S or circle
- Samsung- palm swipe
- Moto – wrist twist or 3 fingers

More useful gestures

- Camera shutter
- Voice activated “Smile” Samsung
- Remote gesture – hold up hand, honor

Things I really like (Phone dependant)



Auto power off - Settings>accessibility set power off and on schedule. Increases battery life. (Honor phones)

eSIM for mobile data abroad. Cheap data when travelling
Settings>mobile network>SIM settings
Phone dependant feature

Safety calls – Settings>Safety and Emergency
Press power 5 times to make SOS call to contacts.
(Most Android phones)
